Chapter 6.04

LIVESTOCK AT LARGE*

6.04.010 Restricted area--Exceptions.

6.04.010 Restricted area--Exceptions.

All of Whitman County is established into a restrictive area, wherein livestock may not run at large; provided, that the following areas of real property located in Whitman County shall be considered open range and shall not be restricted areas wherein livestock may not run at large:

- A. A strip of land one thousand feet in width lying westerly of, parallel and adjacent to the fence along the westerly side of the Oregon-Washington Railroad and Navigation Company right-of-way commencing at the intersection of County Road No. 7010 and No. 7030 in the northeast quarter of Section 18, Township 13 North, Range 38 east, W.M.; and the continuing northeasterly along said right-of-way through Sections 18, 17, 8, 9 and 4 of Township 13 North, Range 38 east, W.M., to a point one thousand feet northwesterly at right angles from the center of the intersection of County Road No. 7030 and the former Hay Canyon Road in the southeast quarter of the northeast quarter of the northeast quarter of Section 4, Township 13 North, Range 38 east, W.M., and there terminating; and
- B. A strip of land one thousand feet in width lying easterly of, parallel and adjacent to the fence along the easterly side of the Oregon-Washington Railroad and Navigation Company right-of-way commencing at a point one thousand feet southeasterly at right angles from the center of the intersection of County Road No. 7030 and the former Hay Canyon Road in the southeast quarter of the northeast quarter of Section 4, Township 13 North, Range 38 east, W.M.; and then continuing northeasterly along said railroad right-of-way through Section 3, Township 13 North, Range 38 east, W.M., to a point one thousand feet southeasterly at right angles from the center of the overpass over said railway company's right-of-way in Section 34, Township 14 North, Range 38 east, W.M. and there terminating; and

- C. A strip of land one thousand feet in width lying westerly of, parallel and adjacent to County Road No. 7030 in Section 34, Township 14 North, Range 38 east, W.M., commencing at the overpass over the Oregon-Washington Railroad and Navigation Company right-of-way in said Section 34 and continuing northerly to the north line of said Section 34 and there terminating. Said one thousand feet to be measured westerly from the easterly right-of-way line of said County Road No. 7030.

6.04.020 Violation--Penalty.

Any person, firm, association or corporation violating any of the provisions of RCW Chapters 16.16 and 16.24 shall be guilty of violation of the laws as therein provided and punished accordingly.

ANIMALS IN PUBLIC BUILDINGS

6.08.010 Definitions.

For the purposes of this chapter, the following definitions shall apply:

"Animal" shall have its normal meaning; provided, however, its meaning shall not include a human being; and provided, further, it shall not mean a legitimate therapy, service or assistance animal when such animal is under the possession, control, or ownership of any person who require such assistance or a dog used by a police department for police work.

"Public building" means only buildings owned by Whitman County.

6.08.020 Prohibition of animals in public buildings.

It is unlawful for any person to bring an animal or cause an animal to be brought into a public building or to allow an animal which is either owned, possessed, or under the control or supervision of said person to remain in a public building.

6.08.030 Violation deemed misdemeanor.

Any person who violates any provision of this chapter shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

POLICE DOGS

6.12.010 Prohibited actions.

No person shall wilfully torment, torture, beat, kick, strike or otherwise harass any dog used by a police department for police work, or otherwise interfere with the use of any such dog for police work by said department or its officers or members.

6.12.020 Penalty.

Any person who violates Section 6.12.010 shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by not more than ninety days in jail, or not more than two hundred fifty dollars fine, or both.
