

Chapter 19.02 – OFFICIAL MAP

Section 19.02.010 - Adoption-Changes-Filing.

1. The county is divided into several zones or use districts as shown on the official zoning map, which, together with all explanatory matter thereon, is adopted by reference and declared to be a part of this title.
2. The official zoning map is comprised of several sections and shall be identified by the signature of the Board of County Commissioners, together with the date of the adoption of the ordinance codified by this title.
3. If, in accordance with the provisions of this title and RCW 36.70.580, changes are made in district boundaries or other matter portrayed on the official map, such changes shall be made on the official map promptly after the amendment has been approved by the Board of County Commissioners.
4. No changes of any nature shall be made in the original map or matters shown thereon except in conformity with the procedures set forth in this title. Any unauthorized change of whatever kind by any person(s) shall be considered a violation of, and punishable under the provisions of, this title.
5. The official zoning map, located in the Public Works Department of Whitman County shall be the final authority as to the current zoning status of land in the county.

Section 19.02.020 - Replacement.

In the event the official zoning map becomes damaged, destroyed, lost, or difficult to interpret because of the nature of the changes or additions thereto, the Board or County Commissioners may, by resolution, adopt a new official zoning map, in whole or part, which shall supersede the prior official zoning map. The new official zoning map may correct errors or omissions in the prior official map, but no such correction shall have the effect of amending the original zoning ordinance or any subsequent amendment thereof.
