



Please use native plants as much as possible.

DIVISION B – ARTISTIC

Artistic Hints:

1. Refer to General Rules.
2. Artistic design shall be the work of the exhibitor. Flowers in Division B do not have to be grown by the exhibitor.
3. Any adult or youth may enter under appropriate section with correct tags.
4. Arrangement featuring wheat shall be in its natural color.
NOTE: Featuring – when a class states an item is to be featured, that item shall provide dominant interest in the arrangement.
5. Dried plants may be treated. Hand-constructed flowers will be accepted in Department 4, Home Economics Building. Hand-constructed vases and wreaths (such as made by wheat weaving) may have arrangements in or on them, and in some cases, woven items could be considered an accessory in an arrangement.
6. Accessories may be used where they contribute to design.
7. No ribbons or bows allowed except in, Section 3 Professional Basket and Arrangements, Section 4,
8. Wearable and Carriables and Wedding Collections, Section 5 Wreaths and Swags.
9. Designs shall be constructed so they can be moved as necessary for the best spacing of exhibits.
10. Flowers, vegetables, fresh or dried plant material may be used in combination unless a class specifies.
11. Do not use paint on fresh plant material.
12. GARDEN FLOWERS SHALL BE DIFFERENT THAN PURCHASED FLOWERS. Subsection (G) will be used for garden flowers; subsection (P) will be used for purchased flowers.
13. "Professional" is defined as any person who has ever worked as a flower arranger and/or accepted payment for flower arrangements. Professional entrants shall identify themselves as such and will be judged separately from amateurs.
14. Accessories are subordinate and shall be a contributing addition to design.

15. Neat mechanics are essential. Always remember the judges look at the backside of your arrangement.

FLOWER ARRANGEMENTS

Scale of points by which exhibit shall be judged:

Arrangement	30 points
Color harmony	20 points
Relationship of material to container	20 points
Distinctiveness	20 points
Quality (condition)	10 points
TOTAL POSSIBLE	100 points

ALL SECTIONS – IDENTIFICATION MUST BE LISTED ON EXHIBIT BY WHICH TO BE JUDGED. EACH IDENTIFICATION WILL BE JUDGED SEPARATELY.

IDENTIFICATION:

- N: Novice – for anyone who has not won more than 5 blue ribbons in artistic design division.
- A: Amateur – for those who have won more than 5 blue ribbons in the artistic design division.
- AA: Amateur Adult - for those who have won more than 20 ribbons in the artistic design division.
- P: Professional – defined as any person who has worked as a flower arranger and/or accepted payment for flower arrangements.
- SC: Senior Citizen - for those who are over age 60.

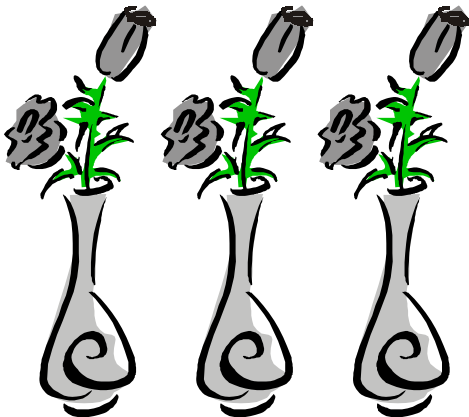
4H, FFA and Open Youth, 19 and under. Will be judged separately. Enter as many classes as desired.

Theme of Fair

Points: Blue 25, Red 20, White 15

Exhibitor limited to 3 entries in each class. Each shall be different type of flowers. Filler and foliage may be repeated. Exhibitor shall provide own basket. No size limit on baskets. This

category includes dried and silk flowers. Ribbon and/or bows are allowed.

Class: Baskets

1. Professional Floral Arrangement in basket, value over \$25 (wholesale value)
2. Smaller Professional Arrangement in basket, value under \$25 (wholesale value)

Class: Arrangements

3. Professional Floral Arrangement, value over \$25 (wholesale value)
4. Professional Arrangement, value under \$25 (wholesale value)

SECTION 4 – “WEARABLES- CARRIABLES”

Points: Blue 20, Red 15, White 10
WEDDING COLLECTIONS

Please show identification of (A) or (P). Ribbons and/or bows are allowed.

Subclasses for all

A) fresh B) dried C) combination D) silk

Class:

1. Corsages on the shoulder
2. Corsages on the wrist
3. Boutonniere
4. Other wearable items
5. Bridal Bouquet
6. Nosegay
7. Arrangement for book or purse
8. Other carryable items
9. Coordinated grouping for a wedding

May include a corsage, boutonniere, flower girl basket, bridesmaid bouquet, bride's bouquet, pew bow, alter flowers arrangement, or other wedding items. Only one entry of each type. Please label each item, but only one entry tag is needed for this.

SECTION 5 – HOLIDAY DECOR

Points: Blue 20, Red 15, White 10

Please show identification (A) or (P). Provide a hook on the back if necessary, for hanging. Ribbons and/or bows are allowed, candles will also be allowed.

Subclasses for all

A) fresh B) dried C) combination D) silk

1. Wreath,
2. Swag, wall or door, not to exceed 36"
3. Table centerpiece
4. Individual place setting arrangement, not to exceed 8", set of four (4)

Points: Blue 20, Red 15, White 10

Provide a hook on the back for hanging.

Class:

1. Using fresh flowers and foliage
2. Using dried silk flowers and foliage

Points: Blue 25, Red 20, White 15
