2:10 p.m. – The meeting was held at the Transfer Station in the office of David Nails. Devon Felsted called the meeting to order.

MOTION by David Hansel and seconded by Eileen Macoll to approve the minutes of June 12, 2018. Motion passed.

On August 3, 2018, a morning fire was discovered in the new building but they were able to continue accepting garbage in the old building by the afternoon.

The damage was \$273,000 and the insurance has covered most of it the cost. They hope to be back in the new building sometime in the middle of October.

Layne Merritt brought the draft of the SWMP for the members. The recycling issue and the UTC rate was discussed.

Under new business, Eileen Macoll announced that the Pullman City Council will be having a town hall meeting in October or early January to discuss recycling issues. There will be more information at a later date as to the location and the time.

After the meeting the members took a tour around the Landfill to the various sites, including the HHW collection, wetland mitigation site, glass crusher and glass collection, yard waste, effluent water tanks, aluminum and cardboard bales, the new building damaged by fire, and the Limited Purpose Landfill.
