NBI Bridge Load Ratings

Whitman County solicits interest from consulting firms with expertise in NBI Bridge Load Rating. Multiple consultants may be selected.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The work to be performed by the CONSULTANT will consist of preparing load ratings on all Whitman County owned bridges. The load ratings will need to meet the current NBI Load Rating standards. Whitman County manages approximately 300 bridges that, due to the updated NBI design vehicle, some of which need new load ratings to be prepared by the end of 2017 and the remainder by the end of 2021.

Submittals will be evaluated and ranked based on the following criteria: 1) key personnel; 2) firm experience with similar projects, 3) ability to meet schedule, 4) past performance 5) past performances/references.
