

Concealed Pistol License

When do I need to have a Concealed Pistol License?

RCW 9.41.050 requires you to have a concealed pistol license when:

- You are carrying a pistol concealed on your person or,
- You are carrying or placing a loaded pistol in a vehicle.

Where do I apply for a Concealed Pistol License?

If you live in the unincorporated area of **WHITMAN COUNTY** you must apply in person at the Sheriff's Office in **COLFAX**. If you live within the city limits of **PULLMAN** or **COLFAX**, you can apply in person at the city police department or Sheriff's Office. Non-Washington residents may apply at any local law enforcement agency in Washington State.

What are the application hours?

Application hours are **8am-11:30am and 1pm- 4pm**. weekdays, excluding holidays. The application process takes at least 30 minutes depending on jail staff availability for fingerprinting. (You may call before coming to apply due to long waits or the inability of jail staff to fingerprint during certain times. Wednesday afternoons may have long wait periods)

Is there a background check?

Yes for original applicants but not renewals. You will need to be fingerprinted and a criminal history background check will be conducted before your license is issued.

Are there other requirements?

Yes. The following requirements must be met:

- Resident of **WHITMAN** County or a Non-Washington resident
- 21 years of age or older at time of application
- Be a United States citizen or a permanent resident alien with a permanent resident card (green card)
- No pending trial, appeal or sentencing on a prohibitive charge
- No outstanding warrants for **any** charge, from **any** court
- No court order or injunction against possessing a firearm
- No mental health prohibitors
- No felony convictions
- No convictions for any of the following crimes when committed by one family member against another on or after July 1, 1993;
 - o Assault IV
 - o Coercion
 - o Stalking

- Reckless Endangerment
- Criminal Trespass in the first degree
- Violation of the provisions of a protection order or no-contact order restraining the person or excluding the person from the residence

How long does it take before I receive my license?

If you are applying for your first concealed pistol license, it may take up to 30 days to complete the background check before the license is issued. If you do not have a Washington driver's license or identification card it can take up to 60 days.

What documents will I need to bring with me?

You will need to bring:

- Picture identification, (i.e. Washington driver's license or identification card)
- A fee of \$48.00 cash, check, or money order made payable to **WHITMAN COUNTY SHERIFF**. This fee is **non-refundable**.

How long is my Concealed Pistol License valid?

Your concealed pistol license is valid for five years from the date your license is issued.

How do I renew my Concealed Pistol License?

If you live in **WHITMAN COUNTY**, you may renew your concealed pistol license in person at the Sheriff's Office in **COLFAX**, during the hours of **8am-4 pm** weekdays, excluding holidays. You may renew your license up to 90 days prior to the expiration date for a fee of \$32.00, or up to 90 days after the expiration date for a late renewal fee of \$42.00. You must provide picture identification and your current concealed pistol license. After 90 days you will be required to apply for an original license with a fee of \$48.00.

What if I lose my concealed pistol license?

If you live in (**WHITMAN COUNTY**), and your license has been lost, stolen or destroyed, you may obtain a replacement license. You will need to apply in person at the Sheriff's Office in (**COLFAX**), during the hours of (**8am-4:30pm**) weekdays, excluding holidays. The fee for a replacement license is \$10.00

Does Washington have reciprocity for Concealed Pistol Licenses with any other states?

Washington has reciprocity or accepts concealed pistol licenses issued by a number of other states, so long as the handgun is carried in accordance with Washington law. The Washington State Attorney General's web site provides a list of those states that have reciprocity with Washington for concealed pistol licenses.
