### **Early Morning Traffic Stop Leads Deputies to Large Quantity of Methamphetamine Intended for Local Distribution.**

**COLFAX, WA-** Shortly after 1:30 am Wednesday morning, Whitman County Deputy Tyler Langerveld initiated a traffic stop on SR 195 just south of Uniontown, WA.

After making contact with and checking the status of the driver, identified as 43yoa Lisa Bond of Clarkston WA, Deputy Langerveld was informed that her driver's license was suspended. Bond was subsequently arrested for the violation. After speaking with Bond, information was obtained that lead Deputy Langerveld to believe that illegal narcotics, likely intended for local distribution, were located in the vehicle.

Based on that information, deputies applied for and were granted a search warrant for the vehicle. During the search of the vehicle deputies located approximately 2lbs of Methamphetamine and several hundred dollar in cash.

Bond and her passenger, 65yoa Elsie Paradiso also of Clarkston, were both arrested and booked into the Whitman County Jail on charges of Possession of a Controlled Substance With Intent to Deliver. Both are set to have their first appearances in Whitman County Superior Court Wednesday afternoon.
